Not only will jumpers be taught a variety of skills using traditional methods, but will also be lead through their own creative process to create routines. All levels of jumpers accepted.

Adult Jump Rope Class

Description: Our instructor is an experienced jumper who enjoys teaching all levels of jump rope as well as performing. Registration 101

What's New? This year for registration, we've worked towards moving the vast majority of the registration online. Instead of everyone filling out individual paper forms, we're asking attendees of JumpStart to fill out the online registration form. This should help speed up information collection and make it easier on both JumpStart organizers as well as those managing teams attending the workshop. Win Win!

Who? Anyone attending JumpStart who'd like to participate in any portion of the workshop should have a form filled out with their information. This includes (but not limited to): jumpers, judges training attendees, a parent who's just watching from the stands and wants to order a boxed lunch, etc.

Example: if a parent of a jumper is planning to attend the judges training, we'd expect an online form submission for the jumper and a separate online form submission for the parent.

Deadline? For discounted pricing, submit online forms by the end of the day, Friday 10/12. Why pay more? Register before the deadline!

After Deadline? Can't commit before the deadline? Don't stress. You can still register after the deadline, but prices will be higher and less options will be available. Example: T-shirt orders MUST be received by 10/12, After that date, they won't be available for ordering. Similarly, Box lunch orders must be received by 10/12 as well. After that date, the only lunch option that will be available is pizza.

Coaches / Team Managers: This online form should help us all, but unfortunately, we aren't going to be able to be completely paper free this year for teams. Bummer! Don't worry though, it won't be much paper. We're asking for one person on each team to fill out the Team Summary Form to tally all your team's totals and collect the team's payment and submit one payment to us. We're helping you with this though in two ways:

- 1) as each form is submitted, your jumper should fill in your name and email address in the "Team Manager" area. This way, we'll automatically copy you on the registration info. **Don't forget to tell them who's email to enter!**
- 2) closer to when you plan to submit, email us if you want and we can filter our registration list by your team and send you what's been submitted up to that point for cross reference.

Trial Run: Just as a heads up, you can give the form a whirl and as long as you **don't submit the form on the "99% complete" page**, it won't come our way. This gives coaches and team managers an opportunity to take a look ahead of your jumpers. It's also good for parents to know what lunch selections are available to ask your child what they want ahead of filling out the form.
